

PGARC Internet Usage Policy

PGARC is distributing the Internet to some locations from our radio sites. This is for exclusive use by local government Emergency Operating Centers and our members. The following conditions apply:

1. To connect to the system, users must be either:
 - a) Members of the Prince George Amateur Radio Club.
 - b) Emergency Operation Centers operating under a State of Local Emergency (SOLE).
 - c) Provincial Regional Emergency Operation Centers (PREOC).
2. This service is “raw Internet”. PGARC provides no security, or filtering of any kind.
3. This network is designed primarily for emergency use. The speed to club members may be reduced during emergencies without advanced warning or notification.
4. PGARC is not an ISP. This service is available at no charge to our members as a benefit of membership with no guarantee of quality or continuity of service. By using the system, you are agreeing to the conditions and limitations of the system and that you accept that there is no security of any kind provided by PGARC.
5. Members connecting to the system are responsible for providing or paying for the necessary equipment. If the club has surplus equipment available, this may be provided to members on a first come, first served basis.
6. Local government EOCs connecting to the system are responsible for providing or paying for the necessary equipment and all costs associated with installing it.
7. The club reserves the right to allow, deny or terminate service for any reason that the board of directors deems appropriate.
8. This service will not be available in all areas.
